## NOMINATION FOR LRCFT EXECUTIVE BOARD MEMBER OR CFT CONVENTION DELEGATE

As a result of remote operations this semester, the process of nominating faculty for positions on the LRCFT Executive Board is being simplified. That process is as follows:

- Indicate that you are nominating someone, including self-nominations, or are supporting a nomination by sending an email to Reina Mayorga at <a href="maybriga@aol.com">myhija@aol.com</a>.
- In the subject line of the email enter "Nomination."
- In the body of the email indicate who you are nominating or whose nomination you are supporting, for which position, and for which college. Open positions are indicated below.
- Indicate that the person you are nominating or whose nomination you are supporting has accepted the nomination. If you are nominating yourself, please indicate that.
- Type your name, since many email addresses do not indicate the full name of the sender.
- Send the email by 3:00 P.M. on November 2, 2020. Nomination emails sent after that are not valid for purposes of nominating candidates for any office.

You must be a member in good standing\* to run for office and/or nominate someone.
